

Early College Academy has canceled all in-person classes beginning Monday, March 16, through Friday, April 3, due to the order announced Thursday by Governor Mike DeWine. Early College Academy will remain open on Friday, March 13.

Governor DeWine announced an order on March 12 to close all K-12 school buildings across the state for three weeks, at least through April 3.

Beginning Monday, March 16, all class and school in-person activities are canceled for three weeks through April 3. Coursework will be provided either online or via pick-up between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. You can also call the school at (614) 298-4742 for updates on assignments.
